**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER’S MOTION FOR TURNOVER OF ASSETS UNDER THE CONTROL OF
CHRISTOPHER FAULKNER**

On the temporary receiver’s (“Receiver’s”) September 6, 2018 Motion for Turnover of Assets, the Court finds, based upon the record evidence, pleadings, and arguments of counsel in these proceedings, that the Motion should be GRANTED.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Federal Bureau of Investigation shall, as soon as practicable, turn over the following possessions to the Receiver, which were seized from Defendant Christopher Faulkner at the time of his June 18, 2018 arrest:

- One Vacheron Constantin No. 143 Luxury Wristwatch
- \$10,726 in U.S. paper currency
- Ten one-ounce gold bars
- One one-gram gold bar, contained on a blue wallet-sized card
- Six gold coins.

The Receiver shall secure the above-listed possessions in a segregated bank safe deposit box, until such time that the Court enters further Orders regarding these assets.
