**RECEIVER’S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO HOLD THE MARCH 28, 2019 FIRST AMENDED
ORDER REGARDING PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION IN ABEYANCE**

Thomas L. Taylor III (“Receiver”), Court-appointed temporary receiver in the above-styled action, respectfully files this Unopposed Motion to Hold the Court’s March 28, 2019 First Amended Order regarding the Receiver’s Proposed Plan of Distribution (ECF No. 424) (“March 28 Order”) in abeyance until such time as the Court considers and rules on any timely-filed objections to the Receiver’s proposed Plan of Distribution.

On April 25, 2019 and May 28, 2019, three objections to the Receiver’s proposed Plan of Distribution were filed by potential claimants to the Receivership Estate. ECF Nos. 429, 436, 437. Additional objections may timely be filed on or before June 26, 2019 (21 days after the Receiver filed his Certificate of Service regarding the Plan of Distribution [ECF No. 440]) (collectively with ECF Nos. 429, 436, 437, the “Objections”). The Receiver’s response(s) to all timely-filed Objections is due on or before July 17, 2019. *See* ECF No. 435.

Material aspects of the Court’s March 28 Order become effective on June 27, 2019, “the 22nd day following the Receiver’s filing of the foregoing certificate of service,” “unless otherwise subsequently ordered by this Court.” March 28 Order at p. 2. In light of the pending Objections,

the Receiver asks the Court to hold the March 28 Order in abeyance until such time as the Court has ruled on the Objections.
