Before the Court is Plaintiff receiver Thomas L. Taylor III’s (“Receiver”) July 1, 2020 Response (ECF No. 17) to the Court’s June 11, 2020 Order (ECF No. 16) to demonstrate good cause, in accordance with Rules 4(m) and 6(b), for failing to effect service on defendants Derek Taylor, Alden Adams LLC, and Nathan Madu (“Defendants”) within 90 days of filing the Complaint; and all opposition, responses or objections thereto, if any. Having determined that the relief requested by the Receiver is fully supported by the written submissions, the Court hereby **GRANTS** such relief. It is therefore

**ORDERED** that the Receiver shall have until, and including, July 31, 2020 to serve the Defendants with process or otherwise move the Court for leave to effect substitute service.
