ORDER


The court has received an inquiry via the Help Desk concerning the status of the temporary receiver’s (“Receiver’s”) April 21, 2021 unopposed motion to approve proposed settlement with Rothstein Kass and expedited request for entry of scheduling order. The court has intentionally held the motion to receive possible opposition responses under the usual local civil rules.

Although the motion is unopposed by plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission, it is unclear that the motion is unopposed by all who are entitled to object to the relief sought. The Receiver’s proposed order, for example, would result in preliminary approval of the settlement as fair and reasonable. Without suggesting that the court will not approve the settlement, or that it will not enter the Receiver’s proposed scheduling order and proposed notices, the court deems it appropriate to await receipt and consideration of possible objections to the Receiver’s April 21, 2021

unopposed motion before ruling on it.
